#### 3. Treasurer's Report – Trevis J. – Report Submitted

I was able to get a new EIN number for our Region since the old one was expired due to us not keeping up with the annual filings that we are required to submit. I also was able to file Articles of Incorporation and Statement of the Incorporator with the Secretary of State through Incfile. I also filed IRS form 8976, Notice of Intent to Operate Under 501(c)(4) and am waiting for final approval with an SS4 form which is what is holding us up in opening a new account at the bank so that we can add other members to the account which we are not currently able to do. I also drafted an Organizational Charter and By Laws which we may need to satisfy the IRS and or the Bank. All of these documents are available for review if needed. I voided check# 1784 in the amount of \$214 which was approved at the last Region for the expenses at the time to file these documents. I used Incfile instead which cost \$80 and an additional \$50 to file form 8976 with the IRS for a total of \$130 which was paid to me check# 1788 at our last P.R. Subcommittee meeting. Our intent once we are granted the 501(c)(4) status is to make policy changes to ensure that the treasurer keeps with up all the necessary legal annual filings to remain in good standing with the IRS and the Secretary of State. As of now, our legal name is Louisiana Area Region of Narcotics Anonymous. This can be changed at a later time if necessary but I didn't want to change it right away because doing so would further delay this already long process.

Greetings from the Convention Board

Hope this weekend finds you all well. Unfortunately, I cannot be in attendance for this meeting, my grandson is graduating from high school, and I am in Ohio for the weekend. Fortunately, Virginia Williams has graciously volunteered to present my repot and answer any questions you may have. I will also be available by phone.

The board has met only once since the last Regional meeting, May 14th, but we have been busy none the less. We have been looking for hotels to be able to hold the convention in for months and we made contact with the visitor's bureau of Baton Rouge.

**Regional Convention Bid** 

Late last year, the Bayou Recovery area gave their blessings for individuals to look for a location around the area for a Regional convention. It looks like the search has finally paid off. We received a proposal from the Marriott Hotel in Baton Rouge. A member of the Convention Board and two members of the bid committee met with the hotel to fill in the gaps of the proposal. They answered all our questions. I sent out the information to the board members, along with a motion to accept the bid from the Marriott as a valid bid. The board has unanimously accepted the bid. A member of the bid committee will be presenting the bid to the Region at the July 10th meeting. Its now up to the Region to vote on the bid.

Where do we go from here?

Once the bid is voted on, and hopefully approved, the next order of business is elections of the convention committee officers. Two members of the board will conduct the elections for, Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer and hopefully secretary. The Chair, Vice Chair and Treasurer will have to be confirmed by the Board. We have a checking account ready along with \$5000.00 in seed money. In the upcoming weeks there will be an election of committee chairs for the convention committee, along with scheduling of convention committee meetings. The hotel

has agreed to allow the committee to meet there for monthly meetings. The board will have an orientation meeting with the committee once it is formed.

Board business and elections

We have a new treasurer, After much discussion we elected Serena Pandos to be the Treasurer. We removed the old signatures from the account and added Serena as a signature on all the accounts. Our next Board meeting will take place August 14th . Ideally, we would like to have elections for the convention committee as soon as possible. The general plan would be July 24th , in Baton Rouge. Once the bid is approved , we will move forward.

Incorporation update

I have not heard anything from the IRS on our tax status. I spoke with our accountant; he was not surprised. He informed me that the IRS is running 6 to 9 months behind, but he would put in a call to see if there is an update.

Board Policy update

We are still tweaking the policy updates and will be voting on the changes at our August meeting.

The convention banner saga

I hope that everyone is enjoying their convention banners. We gave the last of them away at the last Regional meeting. Banners for future conventions have been size limited and we will not be keeping them. The hosting area is welcome to them, or we can auction them off at the end of the convention.

Hopefully we can start to look for the 2024 convention site soon. If there is anyone, or any area willing to host a convention, please feel free to call me or any board member. The longer we have to plan one of these events the better.


