Literature Area Report

Greetings members,

I am submitting my final report as literature chair interim as I have passed on the literature to our newly elected interim literature chair Rocky S. We had our subcommittee meeting with H&I and Policy and we discussed various realistic orders that literature currently makes and there we were able to understand what it takes for literature to break even on the sales of literature to sell them to members at or near our cost. This was discussed at a previous subcommittee meeting with no resolve and we brought this to the last Area with no resolve as well. Subcommittee's are formed to do the work, as many members always attest, so that we free up Area and groups so that our meetings are not bogged down with this from every subcommittees work. Subcommittees are accountable to Area so we are bound to show our work and submit reports for the work that we are doing. The 12 Concepts are the guide to this specifically as I read specific ones last Area to no avail to some.

Currently I am turning over \$416.86 worth of already purchased literature to Rocky with \$19.00 cash on hand. I sold 161.00 worth of literature once I got it from Phillip along with \$49.00 cash on hand that he had leftover. I had ordered \$190.84 worth of literature during that time. If you take the \$190.84 previous orders and subtract the \$49.00 that I received from the previous chair that would be \$141.84. Now add in the \$19.00 current cash on hand and that totals \$160.84. This figure nearly matches the current literature sold of \$161.00.

I went through all of this to show the Area that we are more than capable of handling N.A. funds responsibly and that the Area should have confidence in it's committees that are following the guidelines and policies and submitting accurate reports.

Prices will have to go up on all literature because World is raising the prices. We will access that cost and come up with the price of literature to sell at or near our cost once this happens but for now, we plan on keeping the prices the same until we start ordering literature from World at the new price.

I will submit with this report the literature spreadsheets that document our current inventory and sales.
