 - **Number of treatment centers and locations:** We currently service 3 treatment centers:
 1. Red River Treatment Center, Tioga 1st Tuesday's (Men). 3rd Tuesday's (Women)
 2. Steps Recovery Solutions, Pineville – every 4th Friday monthly
 3. Edgefield Treatment Cheneyville – every 2nd Friday monthly
 - **Number of Correction Facilities and Locations**
 - none
- **Total size of Central Area Fellowship:** approximately 50+/-
- **H & I Activity/plans:**
 - H&I Learning Day- a potential plan is in the works for an H&I learning day/orientation sometime this year.
 - H&I is planning to coordinate with P.R. to start a monthly meeting at one of our correctional facilities.
- **PR Activity/plans:**
 - P.R. contacted one of our local T.V. stations to have them broadcast our newly formed PSA and will continue to contact more stations in our local area.
 - P.R. is in the planning stages of doing our annual poster drive and they continue to keep our local meetings schedules updated in the data base and distribute them to some of our local facilities where H&I does not have panel meetings and other community areas that will allow us to distribute them.
- **Other community activities:** None planned right now.
- **Major accomplishments:** Our Area Activities committee continues to host events in our area, and we invite our local treatment centers to attend. We have combined our sub-committee's due to the small size of our fellowship in our Area and our subcommittee meetings are well attended and the work of these combined committees are being accomplished. We have also started a Women's Meeting on Mondays at 7pm.
- **Specific problems or situations:** We have been informed that federal and state policies that affect our local treatment centers, drug courts and other recovery related programs are not allowed to mandate a 12 step fellowship during and after treatment due to the fellowship using the word God which they consider religious affiliation under their policy of best practices. This is discouraging to the staff at these facilities because they understand the importance of a 12 step program and recommending that to their clients during and upon discharge from treatment. This is one of the reasons why our meeting attendance in our Area has dropped. We are trying to counter this by inviting the treatment center clients to volunteer to attend our functions and meetings and consistently doing H&I & P.R. work there. We also had some members from our local sober living houses such as Oxford and similar affiliations tell us that these places are trying to force and or discourage their residence/clients from attending N.A. meetings.
- **Area plans for upcoming year:** Our Area plans on bidding for the 2024 Convention and we plan on holding our 2023 Convention Fundraiser in late April to early May.
- **Region Donation:** Central Area is donating \$90.00 to LARNA for this Quarter

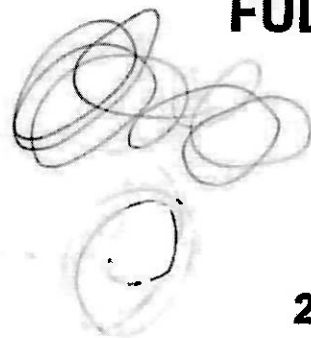
